## GREEN BOATING TIPS

Doing your part in keeping our waterways clean for the future and for marine life only requires a small effort. Do your part by following these tips:

- ✓ Use only paints approved for marine use.
- ✓ When fuelling, do not top off tanks and clean up any spilled fuel.
- ✓ Keep your bilge clean and do not pump oily water overboard.
- ✓ Use bilge absorbents in place of detergents.
- ✓ Do not pump your sewage over the side – use a holding tank.
- ✓ Do not litter and take your garbage home (including cigarette butts)
- ✓ Try not to use detergents – even biodegradable cleaners.
- ✓ Obey all speed limits for better fuel economy.
- ✓ Report pollution: If you accidentally pollute the water or you witness, report it to a Government of Canada pollution prevention office.

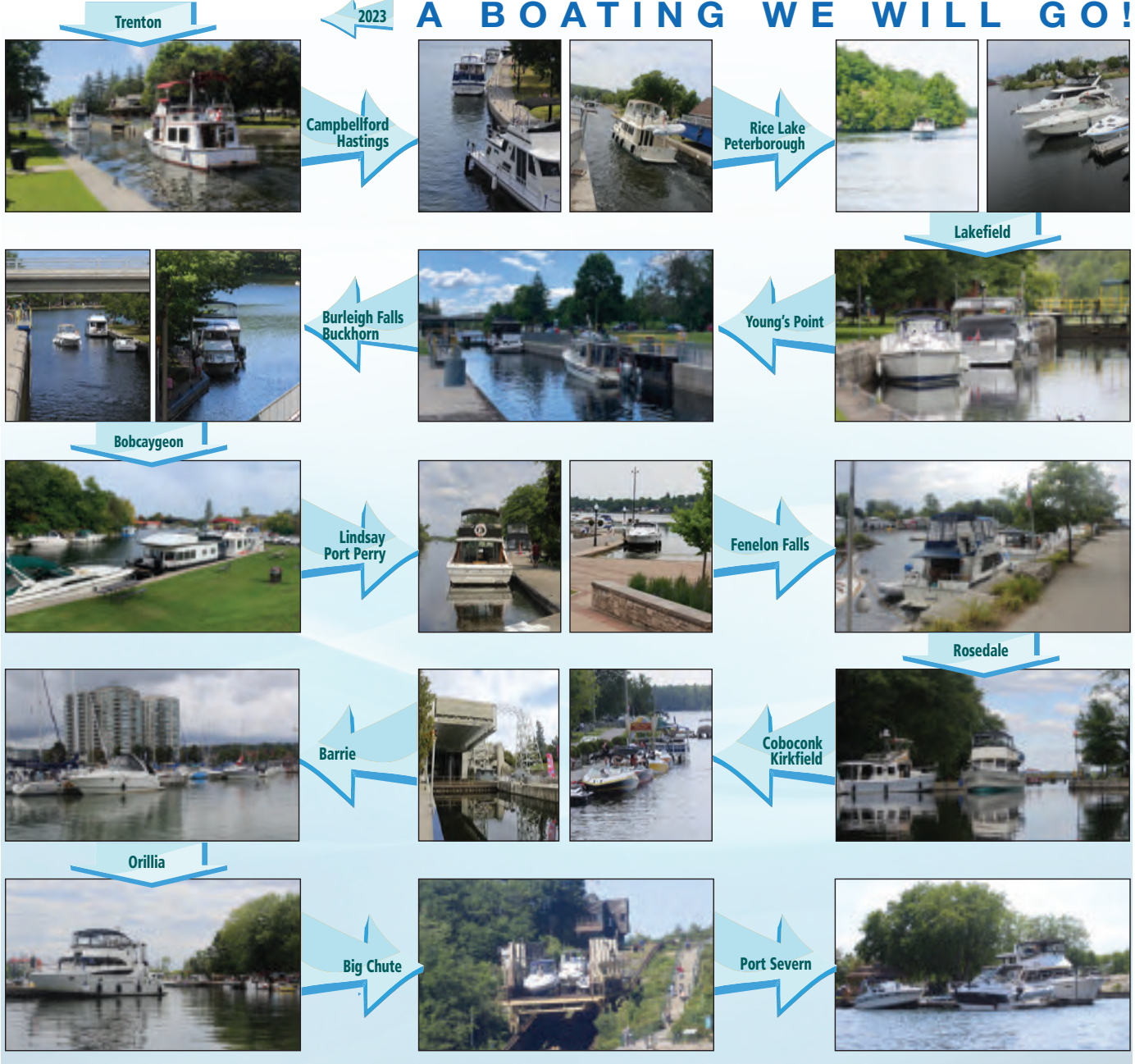

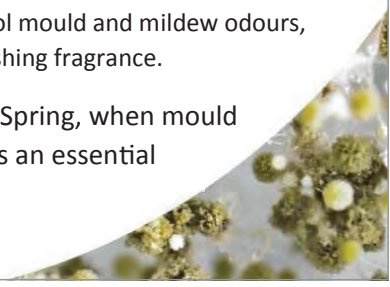

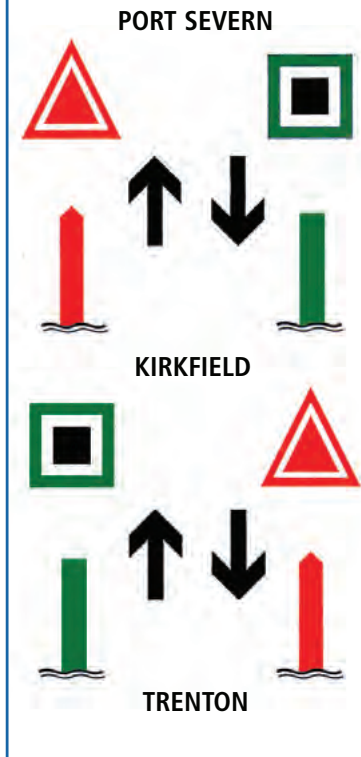
Lateral buoys		Special purpose buoys	
<p><b>PORT</b> (green can) Keep this buoy on your port (left) side when proceeding upstream.</p> <p><b>BIFURCATION</b> (red &amp; green bands) You may pass this buoy on either side when proceeding upstream. The main or preferred channel is indicated by the colour of the topmost band. For example: keep this buoy on your starboard (right) side.</p> <p><b>PORT</b> (green pillar) Keep this buoy on your port (left) side when proceeding upstream.</p> <p><b>FAIRWAY</b> (white &amp; red stripes/white light) You may pass this buoy on either side but when it is marking the middle of the channel it should be kept to your port (left) side.</p>		<p><b>Anchorage</b> Used to mark the perimeter of designated anchorage areas; consult your chart for water depths.</p> <p><b>Cautionary Displays</b> May carry a single yellow "X" shape topmark, yellow light flashing (Fl) 4 s and identification letter(s). Used to mark dangers such as firing ranges, underwater pipelines, race courses, seaplane bases and areas where no through channel exists. Consult your chart for details of dangers being marked.</p> <p><b>Mooring</b> Used for mooring or securing vessels. Be aware that a vessel may be secured to such a buoy.</p> <p><b>Keep Out</b> Used to mark areas in which boats are prohibited. May carry a yellow light flashing (Fl) 4 s.</p> <p><b>Swimming</b> Marks the perimeter of swimming areas. May carry a yellow light flashing (Fl) 4 s.</p> <p><b>Control</b> Used to indicate speed limits, wash restrictions, etc; obey the restriction illustrated within the orange circle. May carry a yellow light flashing (Fl) 4 s.</p> <p><b>Information</b> Used to display information such as locality, name, marina, campsites, etc; be guided by information illustrated within the orange square. # Electrical Safety Authority Help Prevent Electric Shock Drowning

Help prevent electric shock drowning. Make sure your dock's electrical installations and equipment are safe.



## ELECTRICAL SAFETY AROUND THE DOCK



Three tips to help ensure your dock's electrical system is safe:

- 1 The Ontario Electrical Safety Code requires Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) protection for receptacles on floating piers or docks.
- 2 Never use frayed or damaged cords and make sure all marine cords have a ground pin (i.e. three prongs) to prevent electric shock.
- 3 If you suspect an issue with your dock's electrical system, turn off the power at the electrical panel and contact a Licensed Electrical Contractor to check your system.

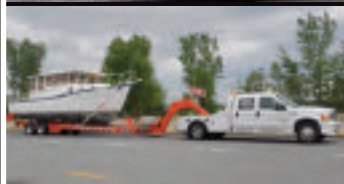

# Area Waterway #27 - Lock 44 Welcome to the Big Chute Marine Railway

The Big Chute Marine Railway, at Lock 44 on the Trent-Severn Waterway, is as unique as it is fascinating. Imagine if you will a large cradle for your boat that allows you to "portage" over land without ever stepping off your boat. The Big Chute works on an inclined plane to carry boats in individual cradles over a change in height that reaches about 60 feet. Not surprisingly, it is the only marine railway of its kind in North America still in use.

This one of a kind piece of engineering provides access between the Severn River and Gloucester Pool. Boats are floated onto the partially submerged Big Chute railway carriage on either the upstream or downstream side and are cradled by a variety of slings. Your boat is moved along a railway track, lifted out of the water, carried over the waterfall and then, with great care, placed back into the water again.

The history of this unique marine railway stems from the manpower and resource shortages brought on by the First World War. Lock 45 at Port Severn was almost completed when war broke out so it was quickly finished as a small "temporary" lock. (It is still in use today). The planned locks at Big Chute and Swift Rapids had not been completed - "temporary" marine railways were built instead. At completion in 1917 the Big Chute Marine Railway could only carry boats up to 35 feet long, although the railway itself was considered an engineering marvel.

The Big Chute Railway is operated and maintained by Parks Canada and



is a huge tourist attraction. At Lock 44 there are large grounds for picnicking, a gift shop, observation deck, visitor centre and of course mooring for your boat upstream and downstream. The main attraction never ceases to be watching the boats get loaded onto the railway car to make the ascent out of the water, across the road and then down the big chute to the water below. Thirty minutes later the process begins in reverse; hundreds of thousands of visitors over the years have marvelled at this engineering wonder.

Whether you travel to Lock 44 by boat or by car, the trip to see the Big Chute Railway is an amazing site to see. Although its one of the most picturesque drives in Ontario, few still know about the winding road that leads to this famous tourist attraction but each year more are finding their way. As for boaters, they have known for years what many others are just discovering - the Big Chute Railway is a virtual roller coaster for boats and as the only still-operating marine railway in North America, a national treasure to be proud of.

# Travelling Through the Locks: Four Basic Steps for Locking Safely

## 1. Approaching the Lock

Obey any posted speed limits between locks or out on the open water. Slow your boat down to a 'no wake' speed. Keep the channel near the lock gates clear to allow boats departing or entering the lock a safe and easy passage.

The painted blue strip (blue line) above and below each lock is a temporary holding area for boaters wanting to lock through. Tie up at this blue line only if you wish passage through the lock.

## 2. Entering the Lock

Remember that during the entire locking through process, you are under the direction of lock operations staff, so please watch for their hand signals, traffic signals or verbal commands.

After the lock gates are opened and departing vessels are clear, lock staff will direct you to enter the lock. At some lock stations, a green traffic light is your signal to proceed. Approach the lock chamber cautiously and follow the instructions of staff.

As you approach an appropriate position inside the lock, have your crew members ready to loop their vessel lines around the black drop cables.

## 4. Exiting the Lock

When the lock operation is completed and lock gate(s) are opened, for safety reasons, please do not restart your engine until directed to do so by lock staff. Check to make sure bow and stern lines are back on your boat and please exit slowly. Exit in order if necessary, or as directed by staff.

## 3. Inside the Lock Chamber

**DO NOT TIE VESSEL LINES TO THE DROP CABLES.**



Once you have safely positioned your vessel the lock chamber, and looped the bow and stern lines around the black drop cables, follow these steps:

(These fire safety symbols appear on lock gate signs at the lock station)



- Turn off all ignition switches (engine, generators etc.).



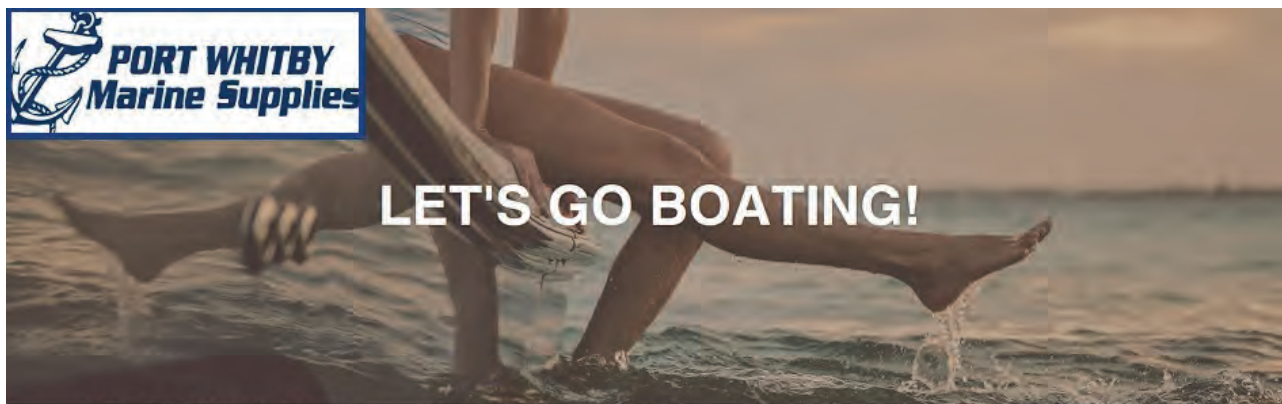
- Turn off all open-flame appliances, including pilot lights, gas powered generators and barbecues.



- Do not smoke above or below vessel deck.



- Leave the bilge blower on throughout the lockage procedure.

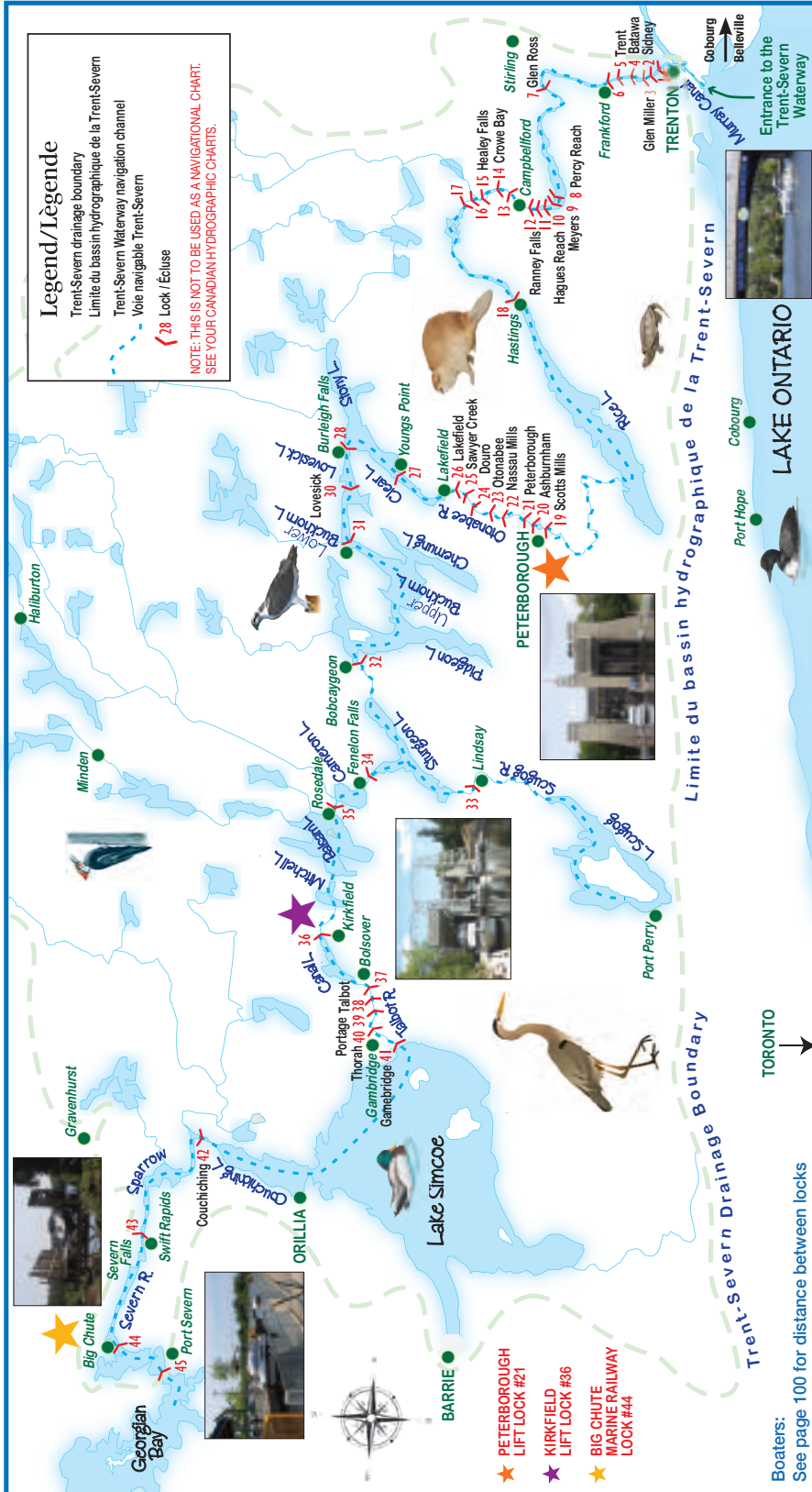

# Boat Ramp Etiquette

I often get asked questions about how best to use a boat ramp while giving due consideration to other users. Often boaters arrive at the ramp and there are others waiting in line to use the same ramp.

The basis for this article originally came from Bill Ballard of the Antique and Classic Boat Society, Michigan Water Wonderland Chapter.

When waiting for the use of a ramp and the lineup can be over an hour long it is very important to be efficient. When boaters have had a late night or trying to get an early start they can be brutal with their suggestions if you hold them up. The exercise of proper ramp etiquette is most important.

## WHILE WAITING IN LINE PREPARE THE BOAT FOR THE DAY:

- Load what you need from your vehicle.
- Check and secure the drainage plug.
- Remove all straps and safety chains.
- Unplug the trailer wiring harness.
- Check the bilge for gas vapour and turn on the blower if necessary.
- Give the gas hose a squeeze.
- Check drive belts for correct tension.
- Check oil.
- Secure your dock lines to the bow and stern so you can launch with the dock on either side.

When the ramp opens up, back in carefully, float the boat off while someone hangs on to the dock

lines and secure the boat to the dock. While the driver parks the vehicle the crew can turn on the blower, get the motor running and warmed it up. Try to keep the total time at the dock to less that a few minutes.

## OTHER ADDITIONAL SUGGESTIONS TO HELP KEEP THINGS MOVING SMOOTHLY:

- Considering the above list and prepare your boat while waiting to use the ramp.
- Have your passengers stay close so you can leave the dock asap. This is a ramp, not a slip.
- When launching roll down your windows so you can hear the docking crew's instructions.
- Leave your bow pennant and stern flag poles stored aboard while launching and recovering the boat as they tend to get in the way.
- A spare set of identified keys will be helpful if a crew member parks your vehicle after launching.

An efficient ramp operation is a thing of beauty. If you are prepared, helpful and ready when the time comes all should go smoothly. Remember these may be your friends waiting in line behind you.

One other important thing I will add. If you offer to help another person with the launch or retrieval of their boat do not do anything without asking them first. If they do not accept an offer of help and provide specific guidance do not do attempt to touch their boat and gear.

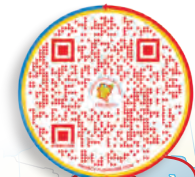

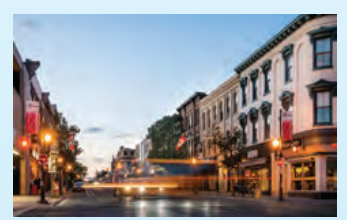

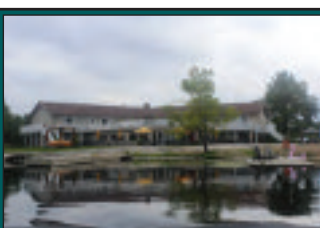

### What is a Trent-Severn Trail Town?

A Trail Town is a destination along a long-distance trail. Our trail is not a land trail, it is a waterway trail. Along the waterway, our Trail Town communities welcome visitors travelling by motor vehicles, boaters, paddlers, hikers and cyclists with warm hospitality and pride of place. They support trail visitor needs with overnight accommodations, food and retail opportunities, activities and attractions.

The Trent-Severn Waterway is a 386 kilometer (240 miles) long canal route connecting Lake Ontario at Trenton to Georgian Bay, Lake Huron, at Port Severn.

There are 44 locks (the first was built in 1833) along the waterway, including 36 conventional locks, two sets of flight locks and two hydraulic lift locks and roughly 32 kilometers (20 miles) of man-made channels. The waterway is a National Historic Site of Canada and its scenic, meandering route has been called "one of the finest interconnected systems of navigation in the world".

There are nine designated Trent-Severn Trail Town (TSTT) communities: Campbellford, Hastings, Lakefield, Buckhorn, Bobcaygeon, Lindsay, Fenelon Falls, Coboconk and Rosedale.

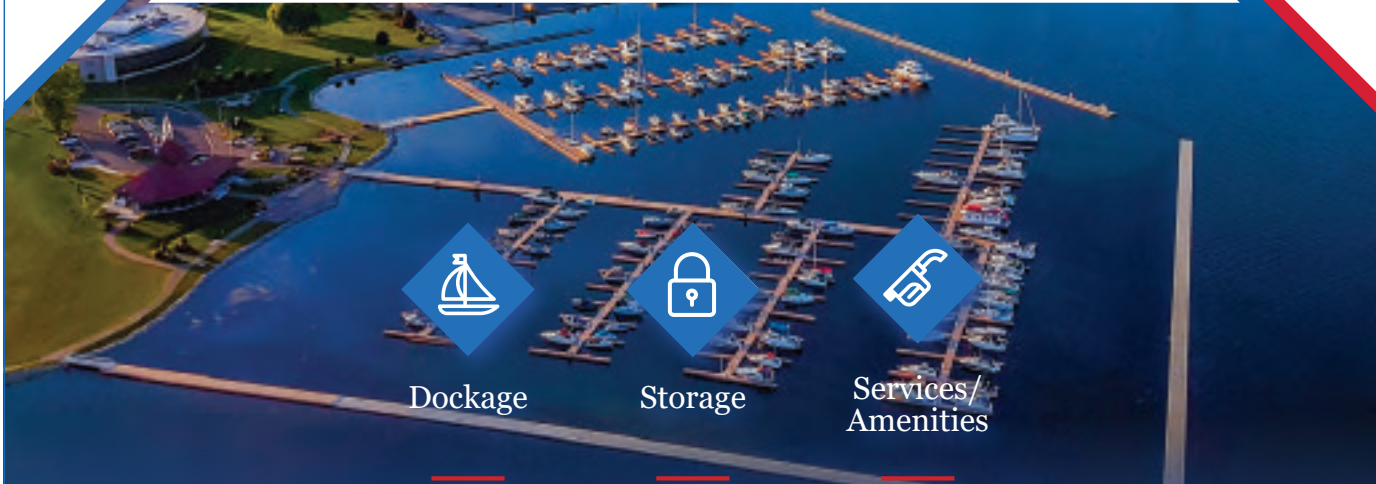

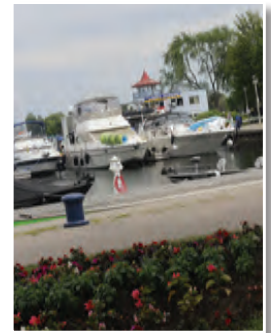

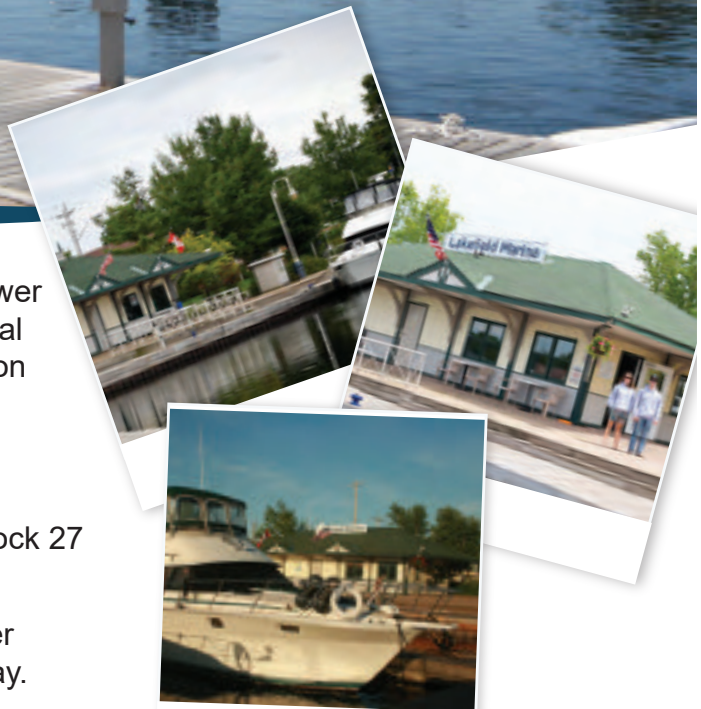

In 1900 a sawmill was built on the site of the Old Mill at Islandview Resort. The sawmill changed hands many times and burned down twice. It was best known as The Johnston Mill and in operation until the 1940s. Where you see the present-day beach area is where in the early

# Area Waterway #13 - Bobcaygeon The Boyd Heritage Museum

Back in 1996, the Village of Bobcaygeon moved to their new building and left the centre core of the Boyd Building empty. Verulam Council, who shared the building, did not need this space. The A. Sheila Boyd Foundation as part owner of the building decided to put a Museum in the vacated space. We opened in May of 1998 after months of planning. We had about 6 display items! Little did we know the work involved in creating a Museum. Items started to arrive from locals who purchased these at the huge Boyd auction in 1983. Twenty years later and an immense learning curve, we have a popular destination for tourists.



A visitor today hears the story of how an Irish immigrant Mossom Boyd became "The Lumber Baron of the Trent Valley" and how he and his two sons established the Trent-Severn Waterway as we know it today, a rail line to Bobcaygeon, and the Trent Valley Navigation Company.

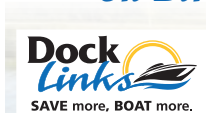

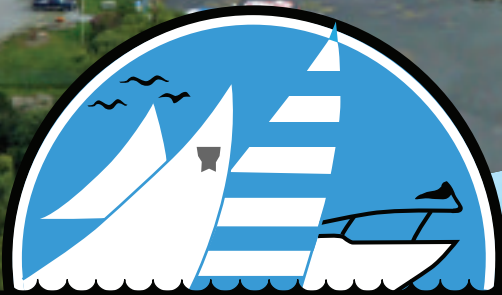
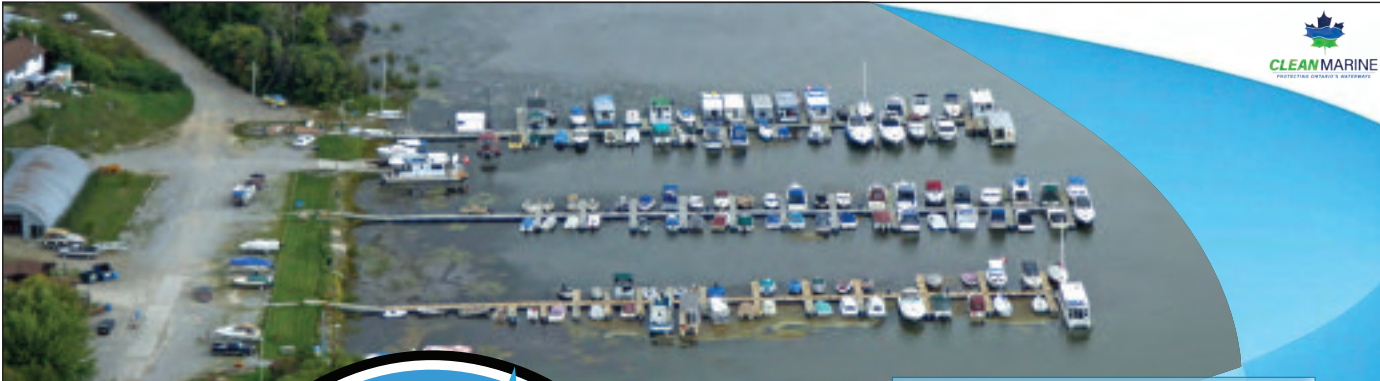

# Area Waterway #19 – Coboconk Welcome to the Town of Coboconk

## Summit of the Trent-Severn Waterway

Coboconk is situated in one of the fingers of beautiful Balsam Lake and it's only a short cruise off of the main channels of the Trent-Severn Waterway.

Coboconk has a rich and unique history amongst the villages of Kawartha Lakes, and has played a prominent role in the logging, limestone, and tourism industries of the region over the past 150 years. The name Coboconk is a translation of the two Indian names for the village, which came from the name of the river: Ko-ash-kob-o-cong, translating to "the part of the river where a portage of a few rods needs to be made" and Quash-qua-be-conk, translating to "where the gulls nest".

The town's Municipal Dock allows for no charge daily and overnight mooring. Within walking distance of the main dock, the community offers marine supplies, gift shops, Home Hardware, accommodations, food, groceries, a laundromat and marine service.

Coboconk, on Balsam Lake, is the highest point of navigable fresh waters in the world. Coboconk is the Summit of the Trent-Severn Waterway with a height of 256.3 meters. Balsam Lake is the highest point in North America in which you can circumnavigate the world.

Whether you travel west toward Lake Simcoe or east into Cameron Lake, both ways are downstream from Balsam Lake. To acknowledge the significance of this hydrologic feature in Kawartha Lakes, an interactive sign and photo opportunity has been erected on the Municipal Dock on Balsam Lake in Coboconk, Ontario, found at coordinates N 44 39.476N -78 47.815W.

Welcome to Trent Talbot Marina which is located on the east side of the Talbot River just before the entrance to Lake Simcoe, a well serviced marina with a family atmosphere. Hosts Sue and Sam Shojaei await your visit, and will make sure that you will not be disappointed.

Lock #41 at Gamebridge, is not a recommended place to stay due to the proximity of a busy road and the accompanying heavy traffic of Highway 12.

Trent Talbot Marina is about a mile downstream from Lock #41 (you won't see the marina from the canal—look for the big sign). Here they offer full transient accommodations, sheltered docks, clean washrooms, showers,

and a marine store.

There are 86 seasonal slips (both open and covered), and although there are no dedicated transient spots, transient boaters can usually be accommodated. Call ahead on VHF 68, or go to the dock for directions on arrival. Depth at the gas dock is 5 to 6 feet, with 4 to 5 feet of water in the overnight slips, which can handle boats up to 45 feet long.

The marine store sells engine parts, charts, hardware, safety equipment, rope and cleaning supplies, and you can also get snack items here.

Remember that Trent Talbot is the last chance for marina services, including gas fill ups, before you venture out onto Lake Simcoe.

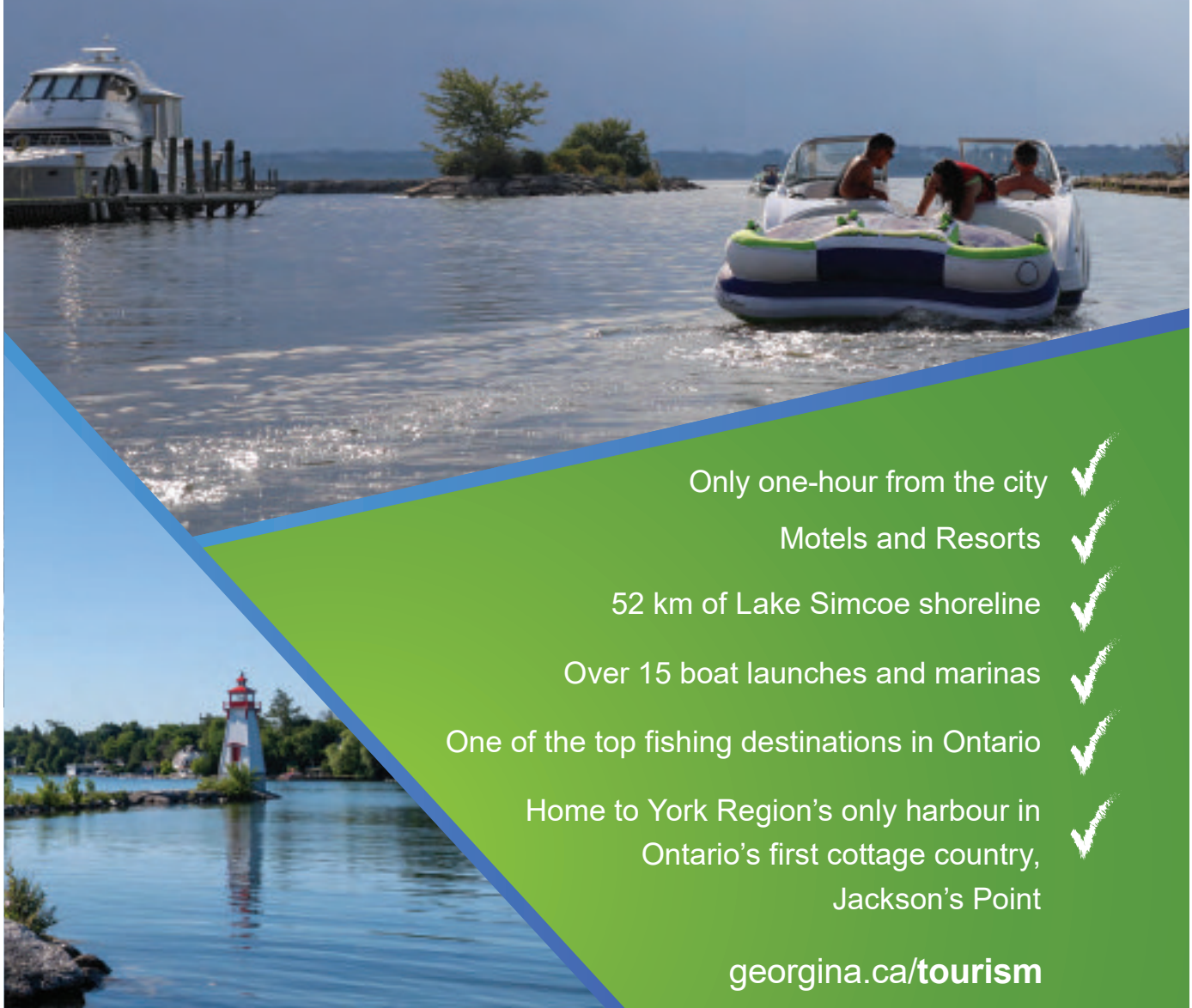

Our Marina is a well established (since 1971) full service facility at the south end of Lake Simcoe on the Holland River. We are easily accessed from the Trent-Severn Waterway and located just minutes from Highway 400 and 404.

Holland River Marina 905-853-6445 is the first marina on the East Branch, on the west side of the river nearly two miles upstream of the junction with the Holland River. A sign is on the dock, but you can't miss the marina: There are about 250 slips, the majority of them covered, for boats up to 42 feet long. (Visitors should go the office on arrival.) The marina has a resort-like feel, with a clubhouse, TV, pool and pool table.



Engine (inboard and I/O - no outboards), electrical, fibreglass and wood repairs are available here, and there is a hydraulic trailer. Parts are available through the service department, and the large marina store carries hardware, accessories, safety equipment, cleaning supplies, clothing, gifts and snacks.

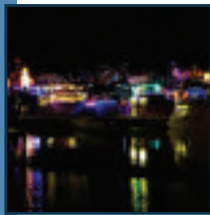

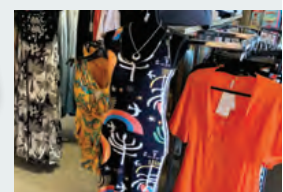
